- Connect clients to organizations that can help them one-on-one in completing applications and ensuring successful enrollment. E-mail referrals can be sent to community organizations that have agreed to provide this type of assistance. These organizations will follow up with your clients to make the enrollment process easier.
- Use the website as a one-stop shop for learning about programs and tax credits. The site is constantly updated to reflect program changes. No need to keep materials about all these programs on hand. The information you need is just a click away.
- Generate data reports that show how many families you screen and how many appear eligible for each of the work support programs. These reports can be useful in understanding client demographics, reporting information to your funders, and identifying client needs.
- Receive a user name and password that allows all of this functionality and more. You can also receive free training on how to use the website to meet the needs of your clients.
