\*\*\* To calculate yearly EAP guidelines for larger households, use this formula: (1.38 + (.03 x number of additional persons above 8)) x \$45,192

\*\*\*\* To calculate yearly CCAP Exit at Redetermination guidelines for larger households, use this formula: (1.38 + (.03 x number of additional persons above 8)) x \$64,423

\*\*\*\*\* To calculate yearly CCAP Exit during 12-month eligibility period guidelines for larger households, use this formula: (1.38 + (.03 x number of additional persons above 8)) x \$68,655

\*\*\*\*\*MA for Pregnant Women income standard is technically 278% FPG.

Please note: Children and adults applying for MA or MinnesotaCare who are 5% or less above the FPG income limit are typically still eligible for the program due to a 5% FPG disregard.
