



## Tax Credits One Pager

Tax credits help fill in the gap between families' income and basic needs. The credits below were created to help maximize the refund of families with children. To understand your eligibility for these tax credits, complete a [Bridge to Benefits](#) screen.

### Child Tax Credit

The Minnesota **Child Tax Credit (CTC)** is a refundable credit of up to \$1,750 per child under 18, with no limit on the number of children. The credit phases out for those whose income is over \$29,500 (\$35,000 for Married Filing Jointly).

### Working Family Credit

The Minnesota **Working Family Credit (WFC)** is a refundable credit for working individuals with qualifying children older than 17.

### Earned Income Tax Credit

The **Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)** is a Federal Tax Credit. It helps low to moderate income workers and families get a tax refund.

### K-12 Tax Credit

The **k-12 Education Subtraction and K-12 Education Credit** help lower taxes and may provide refund for expenses for children in K-12 education. Purchases for most school supplies, field trips, and musical instruments for school band are eligible. You must have receipt for this credit when you file your taxes.
